Use a neutral backdrop to make textiles pop

Before <u>AD PRO Directory firm Stone Textile Studio's</u> redesign of this room, the space was dark. White walls and accents were chosen to complement the light coming in from the large double doors. Then they brought in this blue area rug for a subtle but still impactful pop of color. "The neutral backdrop also allows the textures and materials—like the wood ceiling, delicate drapery, and layered textiles—to stand out without overwhelming the space," says designer Elizabeth Mollen. "The rug was an intentional way to introduce color without disrupting the room's tranquility."
